According to various reports available so far, about 24.7 per cent working children begin work between the ages of 6 and 9, 48.4 per cent between the ages of 10 and 12 and 26.9 per cent between the ages of 13 and 14.

They are working in the streets as beggars, rag pickers, hawkers, shop-assistants, cooks, waiters, head loaders, shoe-shiners and vendors. They are often harased by the colice.

They begin their work from early morning sever o'clock. Most of them are awakened by the traffin police. They are living in between noise and air poliution. They do not bother about their own health any hygiene. They are forced to begin their work from the agric morning in search of their doubt here.

Mostly street children are of four cadres. They are,

- b) The female street child,
- c) The street child who lives with his or h
- d) The street child who lives without his or he family.

The male street children are generally between 7-14 years of age living with their families in paverments and path ways. They are involved in rag picking, metal and scrap collection, hotel cleaning, as hawkers and construction labourers.

The female street child is generally between 7-14 years of age living with her family under the same conditions as her counterparts. They are involved in household work,

baby sittling, look house duties, washing of clothes, and utensits, procuring water and firewood for their homes. They also work as rag pickers, metal and scrap collectors and construction labourers.

Due to quarrefs and mis-understanding, separation or death of parents, many children leave their families. So, they have to live on the road skies and path ways under unitage ylatation. Majority of them are involved in rings pitching, helping at marriage parties and working in ring pitching, helping at marriage parties and working and them to the supported of. Some street children lies with their family on the road sides. Generally they migrate from various places with their family members. Mostly they come places with their family members. These children are willing to study in schools, but that can not do so, because of, lacco of any problems. Once he gets employment, the next problem is to get food and stay. They buy their food at a roae side hotel and path way stalls, because it is cheep and they stay in unhygenic places. Further they change their resting places everyday. They come into contact with bad elements and pick-up habits like smoking, drinking alcohols, taking drugs alc This brings them many diseases and their health is

Street children are the vital problem for all of us. This can't be solved in a day, but in due course by giving education, vocational training and good environment to them. Our country will be led to prosperily, only when they are properly educated,
