- 1 As per the recent National Sample Survey's 61st round on "Some Characteristics of Urban Slums" about 49,000 slums were estimated to be existing in India in 2008-09 when it was around 52,000 in 2000 (53rd round of NSS).
- 2 These are related to municipal finance indicating financial condition of city/town administration.
- 3 Class I cities have population equal to or more than one lakh and Class II towns have population equal to 50,000 or more but less than one lakh.
- 4 Newly formed states, i.e., Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Andhra Pradesh are included in their respective regional states.
- 5 These cities are Greater Mumbai, Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad and Coimbatore.
